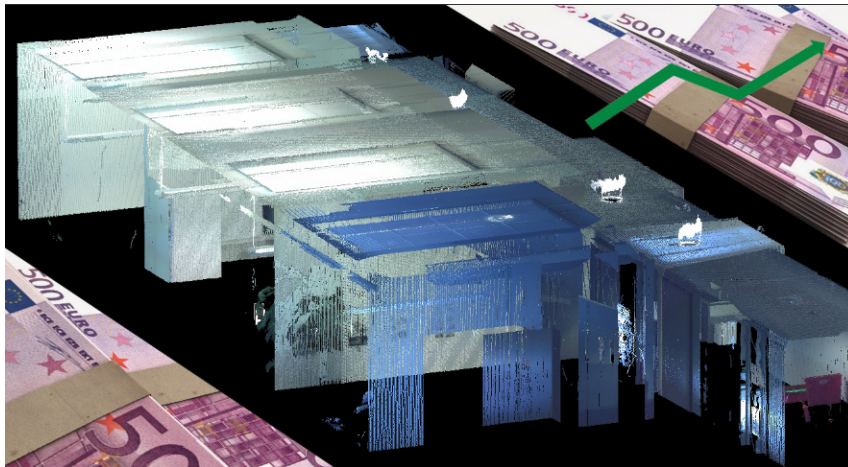
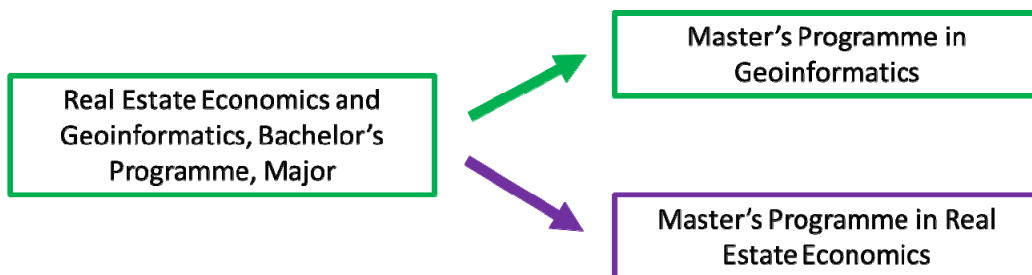


## PHOTOGRAMMETRIC NEWS: New Bachelor's Programme "Real Estate Economics and Geoinformatics" will be launched at Aalto University



Aalto University School of Engineering made a revision of its Bachelor's Programme in 2021. Due to this process, a new Bachelor's major in "Real Estate Economics and Geoinformatics" was established. The teaching language of this Bachelor's major is Finnish. After the graduation from the Bachelor's Programme, the students can continue either to the Master's Programme in Geoinformatics or to the Master's programme in Real Estate Economics. In spring 2022, the application time of this new Bachelor's major starts in the first time, and the studies begin in autumn 2022.

The new Bachelor's major gives a good foundation to continue to the Master's Programme in Geoinformatics. In addition to general studies, such as mathematics, information sciences and physics, the Bachelor's major gives the students an introduction to geodesy, photogrammetry, laser scanning, remote sensing, and geoinformation technology. According to the Bologna process, the complete study path consists of three years in the Bachelor's programme and two years in the Master's programme.

The careful planning of the curriculum makes the combination of real estate economics and geoinformatics a strong combination giving benefits to both fields. In addition, the students have plenty of freedom to focus their studies by selecting interesting courses. From the perspective of geoinformatics the studies of economics partially answers to the long-term request from our stakeholders that the professionals of geoinformatics should have better knowledge of economics as one important working-life skill.
